Approved Minutes of Special **CLEAN AND GREEN COMMITTEE MEETING**

1. **Call to Order/Welcome/Introductions**
The meeting was called to order by Lee at 2:02 p.m.
2. **Public Comment for Items Not on the Agenda**
None.
3. **Approval of Meeting Minutes (Motion)**
Luster made a motion to approve the meeting minutes of March 5, 2020, seconded by Groeper. The motion passed unanimously.
4. **LABT Report**
Romano presented the updated LABT report. She noted that the youth program has been brought back to LABT, and they have been doing all of the weeding of the District.

Romano reported that the LABT team have been experiencing challenges with picking up hazardous waste, human waste and toxic materials within and around homeless encampment areas in the District. Bass stated that Eisenberg will provide a District map highlighting the areas of critical needs that will be sent to CD-4, and CD-13 who have confirmed that additional cleaning crews will be allocated to the District.

Short and Groeper also noted that on the McCadden street side of the Regen Projects building, there is now a problem with trash in the allies and prostitution. Romano stated that all of the allies in the District are cleaned on Mondays.
