Approved Minutes of Special CLEAN AND GREEN COMMITTEE MEETING

1. **Call to Order/Welcome/Introductions**
The meeting was called to order by Lee at 2:02 p.m.
2. **Public Comment for Items Not on the Agenda**

3. **Approval of Meeting Minutes (Motion)**
Bass made a motion to approve the meeting minutes of May 07, 2020, seconded by Groeper. The motion passed unanimously.
4. **Report on Alternative Cleaning Services**
Lee reported on discussions with CleanStreet, a professional street cleaning service that provides street and sidewalk cleaning services throughout California for counties, cities and BIDs. CleanStreet provides those services to the Hollywood BID north of the District. Lee, Bass and Luster have met with a senior representative of CleanStreet to develop a general cleaning plan for the District that would address all of the current needs of the District. CleanStreet uses paid staff and professional machines that have a high capacity to clean and work efficiently. Bass stated that CleanStreet would be able to accomplish much more than the current service in a shorter period of time for less cost than the current cleaning expenses. In addition, CleanStreet has experience in addressing the removal of garbage left behind by those experiencing homelessness and has the capability to address urgent calls for clean up in the District. Bass noted that Eisenberg and Lee revised the Daily Scope of Work with CleanStreet. Eisenberg also created new graphic maps reflecting the cleaning routes for each day.

Lee made a motion for the Clean & Green Committee to enter into discussions to bring about a formal and detailed contract proposal from CleanStreet for cleaning services in the Media District, seconded by Luster. The motion passed unanimously.
