## **Approved Minutes of** **CLEAN AND GREEN COMMITTEE MEETING**

Approved on September 17, 2020

1. **Call to Order/Welcome/Introductions**  
The meeting was called to order by Lee at 2:00 p.m.
2. **Public Comment for Items Not on the Agenda**  
None.
3. **Approval of Meeting Minutes (Motion)**  
Groeper made a motion to approve the meeting minutes of July 02, 2020, seconded by Luster. The motion passed unanimously.
4. **CleanStreet Report**  
Lee and Eisenberg both reported on the excellent responsiveness and effectiveness of CleanStreet, particularly with addressing noticeable problem areas throughout the District. On all incoming notifications, Joaquin Jimenez, the Supervisor of the CleanStreet team, communicated with Eisenberg immediately and advised when he would be able to have the team respond. Response times have been excellent – typically same day cleaning upon receiving a request. In addition, Stakeholders and Businesses have provided positive feedback on the service.
5. **District Areas of Concentration**  
Joaquin Jimenez reported that several days a week are focused on returning to the areas of concentration in the District so that there is an ongoing schedule of cleaning. Jimenez also reported that a few of the District trash cans were being over utilized. Jimenez and Security will monitor the trash cans and provide an updated report to the Committee.
6. **Median Landscaping and Repair**  
Lee discussed with the Committee that the drip irrigation system in the Medians was not properly repaired by the previous vendor and needed to be repaired. In addition, certain areas of the irrigation system were found to have been destroyed and need to be replaced. CleanStreet will provide an estimate to repair the drip irrigation system.



7. **Graffiti Abatement**

The committee agreed that Stakeholders or businesses would be responsible for providing matching paint for their building. CleanStreet will try to remove any graffiti by pressure washing first. If that does not work, then the area will be painted. CleanStreet has generic white and off-white paint colors available to use as needed, on a case by case basis.

8. **Landscape Design for Medians**

The committee discussed the need for landscaping the medians. Eisenberg advised that she would research landscaping companies and request estimates.
