PROJECT OVERVIEW

The City of Los Angeles is working on safety improvements in your neighborhood. And we want to hear from you!

The Mid City West Neighborhood Council (MCW NC) and the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) secured grant funds to improve walking and bicycling in Mid City (see map). These streets are part of the City of Los Angeles's Mobility Plan, and were originally identified as residential streets with low vehicle traffic and speed limits of less than 25 mph. These kinds of streets are ideal for walking and bicycling. Safety improvements will encourage more bicycling and walking -- and will make these streets even safer for residents.
